About the role

IWater is the body for those working in and around the UK water sector. IWater is licensed to offer 9 Professional registrations – 3 each in Engineering, Environment, and Science.

To make this happen, registration relies on a terrific team of volunteer Assessors. They work in pairs to ensure that quality standards are maintained consistently and help guide applicants through the process. Assessor experience also opens up CPD opportunities with national licenced bodies where your input can help support and steer future policy development.

Time commitment

- Participate in 2 to 4 assessments per year, typically involving a review of written materials and candidate interviews.

- Engage in occasional communication and preparatory work between assessment sessions.
- Complete a brief annual training refresh to stay up to date.
- Each assessment requires an estimated 6 hours total commitment.
